The composition reflects the period's Romantic fascination with nature, game, and aristocratic sporting culture, combining naturalistic detail with a quiet narrative drama. The fluid handling of watercolor and harmonious landscape setting suggest the hand of a trained artist working within the sporting and academic traditions of the era.
