PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Mid-20th Century French Lacquered Coffee Table France, mid-20th century This elegant French coffee table dates from the mid-20th century and features a finely lacquered rectangular top richly decorated with gilt chinoiserie-inspired motifs. The surface is executed in a deep, variegated green lacquer, displaying subtle tonal shifts and natural patina that lend depth and softness to the composition. The top is adorned with a lyrical scene of flowering branches, birds in flight, and stylized symbolic objects, arranged within panelled reserves and framed by dark lacquer borders. The gilded decoration stands in warm contrast against the green ground, creating a balanced interplay of color and graphic clarity that is both decorative and refined. The table rests on square-section black lacquered legs, accented with restrained gilt linear detailing and terminating in stylized feet. A shaped stretcher beneath the apron provides visual cohesion and structural support, reinforcing the table's clean, architectural profile. The combination of traditional Asian-inspired ornament with a simplified modern form reflects the enduring French fascination with chinoiserie, reinterpreted through a 20th-century decorative arts sensibility.
