PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

19th century carved Bugbear coconut mounted on a 3.5" H wood and metal stand. 'Bugbear' coconuts were carved on long voyages by sailors who had visited the Tropics and collected the 'green nuts', which were easier to carve while still young and fresh.
