EXQUISITE PIED PEACOCK TAXIDERMY: A MAJESTIC DISPLAY OF RARITY AND ELEGANCE

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This finely preserved taxidermy specimen depicts a Pied Peacock, a rare and visually striking color morph of the Indian Blue Peacock (*Pavo cristatus*). The pied variety is characterized by its distinctive pattern of pure white feathers interspersed with areas of iridescent blue, green, and black—a result of leucism, a genetic condition that causes partial loss of pigmentation while preserving the bird's characteristic form and eye-patterned train.

Mounted on an elegant oval wooden base, the peacock stands approximately 6 feet tall, with its dramatic plumage carefully arranged to emphasize both scale and balance. The detachable tail allows for flexible display, enabling vertical or more relaxed positioning depending on placement and interior context. Large peacock mounts of this type were especially favored in the late 19th and early 20th centuries for grand interiors, winter gardens, and natural history displays. Highly prized for its rarity and visual contrast, the pied peacock combines natural beauty with historical decorative tradition. This example offers both sculptural presence and natural history interest, making it well suited to a library, entry hall, or curated interior. Approximate height: 6 feet
