Typically foraging in small, cautious groups throughout most of the year, the Blue Eared Pheasant forms pairs during the breeding season, adding a touch of elegance to its life cycle. Unfortunately, due to hunting pressures across its range, this magnificent creature has grown increasingly wary and tends to seek refuge in remote, untouched landscapes, far removed from human settlements.
