PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Cast Iron Baby Bath This charming cast iron baby bath dates to the 19th century and exemplifies the utilitarian yet decorative domestic wares produced during the period. Cast in a graceful oval form, the bath features gently flared sides, a rolled rim with molded detailing, and raised ends with subtle ornamental motifs. The vessel rests on small integral feet, allowing it to stand securely while in use. The surface retains a deep, naturally aged patina consistent with long-term use, lending warmth and authenticity to the piece. Such baths were designed for durability and hygiene, commonly used in private homes before the widespread adoption of built-in plumbing and modern enamelware. Today, the piece works equally well as a sculptural decorative object, a planter, or a distinctive display element in both rustic and industrial interiors. Dimensions: 23" L x 11" W x 8.5" height
