Its distinct features include a white head with a black narrow band across its eyes, grey legs, brown iris, and red skin surrounding its eyes. Notably, the Reeves's Pheasant made its mark in the Guinness World Records 2008 edition for possessing the longest natural tail feather of any bird species, measuring an impressive 2.4 meters (8 feet).
