PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Still Life with Peaches J. Payne, circa 1940s Oil on canvas, signed upper right and verso This mid-20th-century still life presents a shallow bowl of ripe peaches rendered with bold, expressive brushwork and a richly saturated palette. Thickly applied paint emphasizes the fruit's rounded forms and velvety skins, with glowing reds, oranges, and hints of violet set against a simplified, warm-toned ground. The composition reflects the continued influence of Post-Impressionist and modern European still-life traditions of the period, prioritizing color, surface, and immediacy over strict naturalism. Though J. Payne remains a relatively undocumented painter, this work demonstrates a confident handling of paint and a refined sensitivity to balance and chromatic harmony typical of studio practice in the 1940s. Presented in its original carved and painted frame, the painting retains strong decorative and period appeal. Dimensions (framed): 17.75" L x 1" W x 13.5" H
