Dean Wolstenholme (1757–1837) *Fox Hunting in England* Oil on canvas depicting a spirited English fox-hunting scene, with huntsmen in traditional scarlet coats and black top hats mounted on horseback, leading a lively pack of hounds in full pursuit through a wooded clearing. The composition captures the energy of the chase against a rolling countryside landscape, rendered with a keen sense of motion and atmosphere beneath a glowing sky. Wolstenholme, an accomplished sporting artist of the late 18th and early 19th centuries, was celebrated for his dynamic representations of the hunt, game, and rural pastimes. A member of a family of painters dedicated to sporting subjects, his works are notable for their acute observation of equestrian form, canine vitality, and the traditions of English country life.
